There would be scones, jam and cream, iced fancies, meringues and fruit cake, popularly known as "cut and come again cake". During the afternoon carriages would arrive at regular intervals. Ladies bedecked in their latest finery, protected against the suns glare by delicate parasols, would gather on the lawn. Coachmen and gentry alike ate extremely well, and they all said they loved to come to Plas Tan-Yr-Allt.

Carrying on this delightful and traditional aspect Miss Hilda's Edwardian Cream Tea is taken in the Drawing Room or during the Summer months on the Veranda between 3pm and 4:30pm.

Your afternoon tea is served from a special cake stand and is complimented by bone china and silverware. The centrepiece being of course the drink itself whether you prefer a freshly brewed pot of tea or a continental café press of specially ground coffee.
